### WHAT IS QUICKSTART?

QuickStart Tennis is an exciting new play format for learning tennis, designed to bring kids into the game by utilizing specialized equipment, shorter court dimensions and modified scoring, all tailored to age and size. It is divided into two different levels-- 8 & Under, 10 & Under.

Players in the 12 & Under age division will use regular size equipment and play on full tennis courts.

### WHAT IS USTA JR. TEAM TENNIS?

USTA Jr. Team Tennis is the largest youth tennis program in the country, helping girls and boys get on the court, and have a good time. It has been developed to give children the opportunity to play tennis as a team sport just the way they are able to play soccer, basketball, and baseball.

USTA Jr. Team Tennis is a 8 to 10 week program of team practice and match play. Jr. Team Tennis focuses on fun, fitness, and the social benefits of tennis.

### WHO CAN PLAY?

The USTA Jr. Team Tennis using the QuickStart format is for all children ages 12 & under. Whether or not your child has ever held a racquet, there's a spot on a team for them!

### WHY PLAY TENNIS?

Tennis is a lifetime sport that has been scientifically shown to develop discipline and work ethic as well as learn teamwork and social skills. Additionally, tennis helps improve aerobic and anaerobic fitness levels, increase speed and agility, develop strength and flexibility and refine hand-eye and overall body coordination.

### PLAY FORMATS

**8 & Under Division:** First to seven points wins one game and best-of-three games wins the match.

**10 & Under and 12 & Under Divisions:** Each match will consist of five courts—three singles & two doubles court. Best-of—three set to four wins the match.

### REGISTRATION FEE

\$76.48 Registration fee includes: balls, court time, coaching & instruction, USTA membership as well as a Nike Dri-FIT team shirt. The fee is broken down into (\$19.00 USTA membership, \$16.48 shirt, and \$41.00 GSCYTA local league fee which helps cover cost of equipment), totaling \$76.48. Deadline to register: April 25th
