Qualifications and Selection Criteria

Established April 24, 2007

Applicant must be a Kentucky high school senior, a USTA member, plan to attend college and continue tennis participation as a competitive college player, intramurals, club programs or local tennis leagues.

Applicant must exhibit contributions to community service.

Applicant must prioritize team effort, team spirit, sportsmanship and leadership; either by high school tennis team participation or selected USTA Kentucky team sponsorships in a team atmosphere.

Applicants must support participation in USTA Kentucky sponsored tournament, including play in the Jason Isaacs Memorial Doubles Tournament.

Applicants must have a letter of support from a coach or teacher included with their application.

The number of \$1,000 scholarships to be awarded will be determined annually by the reserve amount set in the Jason Isaacs Memorial Scholarship reserved funds administered by the Raise a Racquet Foundation.
